Important Notice: Child Trust Fund Eastern Region. You may remember that individual Child Trust Fund accounts were opened for all children born in the UK between 1st September 2002 and 2nd January 2011. At the age of 16, they are allowed to take control of their account and at 18 to access the money. Many families do not know how to access their accounts or didn't register them following the opening with HMRC. If you wish to find out more information and how to find out if this applies to your young person there is an event taking place on **Tuesday 20th July at 7pm**, there are limited spaces available, however, sessions will be run periodically.
