Dear Parents/ Carers,

**Transport** – If your child is in receipt of home school transport, it is important to either, complete and return the forms which have, or are due to be, sent to you, direct from your LEA. Please express your intention to continue receiving this service. Alternatively, in the case of leavers, please inform your LEA that you will no longer require transport for the following academic year.
