Teeth – Will your young person allow you help them brush their teeth? Very often, a young person who has autism will have sensory issues, which will impede them from allowing you to help with dental hygiene. Weather – The weather has turned a bit colder, please make sure your child has a coat and hat with their name in.

Covid 19 – Please test your young person twice weekly, irrespective of whether or not they are showing any symptoms or if they have been vaccinated. Should you need any kits please contact the school office via email, or your class teacher.

If your child is sent home unwell, you are required to keep them off school for the following two days at least, and not send them back unless they are symptom free.
