Drama Centre Fun!

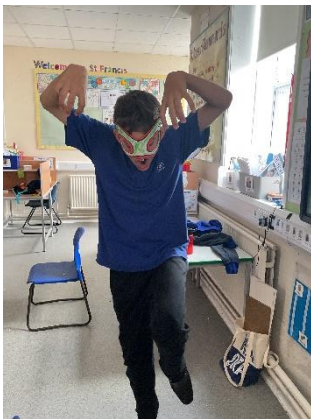
St Patrick's have been enjoying their drama sessions at The Redbridge Drama Centre!

At St John's, we are always learning from our parents and carers. We would like to share some of the resources, activities, and tools that families have found helpful.

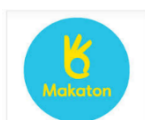

Money Money Money

These days the majority of our purchases are made using cards. Many parents, teachers and students find payment cards helpful for students to use. A child can be as young as 6yrs to have their own card. Banks like Starling offer 'Kite Spaces' for 6-16 yrs where the adults can monitor spending on the app. Banks like Halifax offer debit cards from 11yrs and they can see their own spending on the app. There are also cards like Go Henry that offer more features related to pocket money.
